

CAMPER FAQ'S

Q: Do I have to pack for the full two or three week program or will I be able to do laundry while at camp?

A: For Jr LIT please pack enough clothing for the week laundry is not available. For Sr LIT and CIT we ask campers to pack enough clothing for their stay however part way through the program laundry days will be provided to campers.

Q: I have been coming to camp for years and really want do a leadership program early why can't I?

A: We understand the love our campers have for Jubilee! We ask that all participants register for leadership programs based of the minimum age requirements. We understand people are eager to start early however the programs are developed and based around certain ages. If you have further questions have your parents call the office to discuss the matter further.

Q: I've never come to Camp Jubilee before but am old enough for leadership can I register?

A: new campers are always welcome, Sr LIT is a perquisite for the CIT program however the Jr LIT program is not mandatory. If you are the correct age for leadership feel free to register for any leadership program.

Q: I don't think I want to work at camp, can I still register for a leadership program?

A: Of course we enjoy employing our leadership graduates after the successful completion of our leadership programs however understand that that may not always be the case. We encourage all teens to register for leadership programs to help develop transferrable life skills.

Q: What is the difference between traditional camp and leadership programs?

A: All leadership programs are a transition from traditional camp programing with a focus on developing leadership skills. Leadership participants will still be able to participate in camp activities however will be learning the behind the scenes of each area. Leadership programs are designed to help transition campers to staff members with skilled leadership skills.

A: We ask that campers that select our leadership camps are wanting to learn and develop fundamental leadership skills. If your camper is not interested in the program have them read through this information package and see if it is something that may interest them. There is an interview process for SR LIT and CIT in the winter months that will be held in our office in Port Moody.
