I don't know anyone will I be alone? Not at all! Plenty of campers come to camp by themselves and leave with life long friendships.

What if I get homesick, can I leave? Our staff are very familiar with homesickness and will work with campers to make their week at camp the best one yet. We will work with campers and ensure that leaving camp is the last choice!

Can I share a cabin with my sister or brother? Unfortunately we house our campers in the same self identified gender so unless you are both of the same sex and same gender we are not able to accommodate family cabin requests.

Where do we sleep, do we have an adult with us? Campers sleep in cedar cabins or yurts. All sleeping spaces hold beds for 10 people and have a wash-room as well as electricity. There are 8 campers to a cabin so that two beds are available for staff members.

What if I don't like the food? We do our best to make our menu as kid friendly as possible. If you don't see anything you like on the buffet line please talk with your counsellor and they are more than happy to help find you something at each meal.

PARENT F.A.Q.'s

If I have children in multiple age groups, can I drop them off at the same time?

YES! If you have campers that fall into different age categories in regards to boat departure times, we will schedule them for the same boat.

Do I have to wait with my camper(s) until the boat leaves? YES! All parents/guardians are required to stay with their campers until the boat departs.

How long is the boat ride to camp? What island is the camp on? The boat ride is 45 minutes from Cates Park to Camp Jubilee. Camp Jubilee is NOT on an island; it is approximately halfway up Indian Arm on the mainland. Our address is 0 Orломah Beach. It is only accessed by boat because the road doesn't go that far.

What if my child gets homesick? All Camp Jubilee staff are trained to identify and manage homesickness. Camp staff work to ensure campers are comfortable at camp, making friends and kept busy with activities each day. If a camper is experiencing homesickness, our staff will quickly respond to any anxieties or concerns. We rarely allow campers to call home as this tends to exacerbate the homesickness—however depending on the situation, calling home maybe an option. The Camp Director will contact you (the parent) and update you on your camper if needed.
