Camp Jubilee is located in North Vancouver. We are a boat access camp with that transport's guests and staff to/from Cates Park. Camp Jubilee operates from March 1- October 30 annually and caters to school, youth, family and adult groups. We have 128 acres of waterfront property with 180 guest beds and approx. 40+ staff members.

This opportunity will last the full length of our summer camp program. This includes a four day staff training period. Successful applicants will be required to work on-site for their five day shift each week. Staff will be taken off-site to Cates Park for their time off period and breaks will be provided each day on site for staff to relax and socialize.

Our summer camp program is accredited by the BC Camping Association, and we are proud to do our part to provide safe and quality camp experiences to our campers. Our mission is to ensure that all families have the opportunity to send their children to camp and furthermore that all children are able to have that opportunity.

Camp Jubilee staff in all positions are expected to be always respectful and professional. This includes treating colleagues and guests kindly, wearing a staff uniform, following Camp Jubilee policies, and helping to create a warm and positive community for others.

Camp Jubilee – Cabin Leader

The “Cabin Leader” is our quintessential camp counselling role during our summer camp program. Cabin Leaders are assigned a cabin of up to nine campers and are the primary leader for these campers throughout their camp experience.

Cabin leaders are responsible for ensuring that campers have a safe and exceptionally fun experience at Camp Jubilee. This includes making sure that campers are behaving appropriately in their group, following safety and hygiene policies, and participating in activities to the best of their abilities. Cabin Leaders have an incredible opportunity to be a positive and engaging role model in the lives of our campers and we hope that Cabin Leaders fully embrace that opportunity and create amazing and life changing experiences.

The Cabin Leader sleeps, eats, plays, and talks with the campers throughout each day. This person will lead activities, teach skills, run games, and manage any issues within the cabin. Above all else, the physical and mental safety of each camper is the cabin leader’s primary concern.

Campers will often look up to and admire their Cabin Leaders. It is expected that all Cabin Leaders act as good role models for their campers and treat each camper with respect and fairness.

Cabin leaders will spend almost all of their working time with their campers and will also be their primary instructors. It is the job of the cabin leader to supervise their campers at all times and to prepare them for the activities they will be participating in. The work of a Cabin Leader is extremely fun and rewarding, but can also be rather demanding. For this reason, we have different support systems in place during our Summer Camp program that Cabin Leaders are expected to utilize to assist in providing those amazing experiences.

Section Leaders, Camper Assistance team members, and Co-Counsellors are examples of roles at Camp Jubilee that are designed to provide assistance to Cabin Leaders where possible and when needed.

Sampling of Responsibilities:

- Ensuring that all campers are safe and always supervised
- Leading campers through all the activities in their weekly schedule
- Being a positive role model for campers
- Following camp policies to ensure that any problematic behaviours are being handled appropriately and by the correct team of staff.
- Provide primary first aid care for any injured camper.
